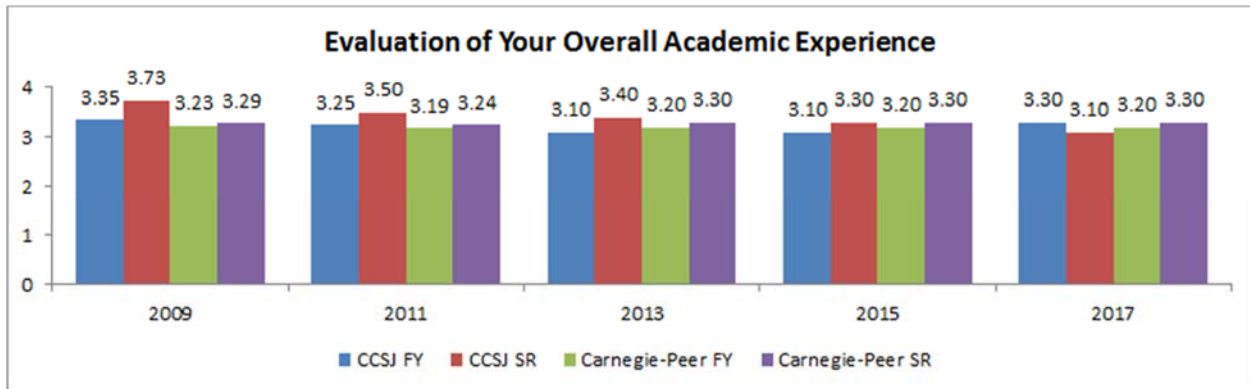


Figure 51 – NSSE - Evaluation of Your Overall Academic Experience (evalexp)
