

C. Dependent Student's Income Information to Be Verified

1. TAX RETURN FILERS—Important Note: If the student filed, or will file, an amended 2015 IRS tax return, the student must contact the financial aid administrator before completing this section.

Instructions: Complete this section if the student filed or will file a 2015 income tax return with the IRS. *The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of FAFSA on the Web. If the student has not already used the tool, go to FAFSA.gov, log in to the student's FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if the student is eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2013 IRS income tax information into the student's FAFSA. It takes up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for the IRS Data Retrieval Tool for electronic IRS tax return filers, and up to eight weeks for paper IRS tax return filers. If you need more information about when, or how to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool see your financial aid administrator.*

Check the box that applies:

- The student has used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool in FAFSA on the Web to retrieve and transfer 2015 IRS income information into the student's FAFSA, either on the initial FAFSA or when making a correction to the FAFSA. *The student's school will use the IRS information that was transferred in the verification process.*
- The student has not yet used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool in FAFSA on the Web, but will use the tool to retrieve and transfer 2015 IRS income information into the student's FAFSA once the student has filed a 2015 IRS tax return. *See instructions above for information on how to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. The student's school cannot complete the verification process until the IRS information has been transferred into the FAFSA.*
- The student is unable or chooses not to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool in FAFSA on the Web, and the student will submit to the school a **2015 IRS tax return transcript**—not a photocopy of the income tax return. *To obtain an IRS tax return transcript go to www.IRS.gov under the **Tools** heading click on "Get a Tax Transcript" then click on **Get Transcript by MAIL** link or call 1-800-908-9946. Make sure you order the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "IRS Tax Account Transcript." For paper request forms, print and complete IRS Form 4506T-EZ or 4506-T. It takes up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for electronic IRS tax return filers, and up to eight weeks for paper tax return filers. If the parents are married, and separate 2015 tax returns were filed, 2015 IRS tax return transcripts must be submitted for each parent.*
 - Check here if the student's IRS tax return transcript is attached to this worksheet.
 - Check here if the student's IRS tax return transcript will be submitted to the student's school later. Verification cannot be completed until the IRS tax return transcript has been submitted to the student's school.

1. TAX RETURN FILERS—Important Note: If the student's parent(s) filed, or will file, an amended 2015 IRS tax return the student's financial aid administrator must be contacted before completing this section.

It takes up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for electronic IRS tax return filers, and up to eight weeks for paper tax return filers. If the parents are married, and separate 2015 tax returns were filed, 2015 IRS tax return transcripts must be submitted for each parent.*

- The parent(s) was employed in 2015 but made less income than required for tax filing.
*A copy of the Affidavit of Self Support form, all 2015 W-2 forms, and a 2015 Tax Return Transcript of **Non-Filing** are attached. Parent will need to mail in to the IRS the Request for Transcript of Tax Return Form 4506-T to receive a transcript verifying you did not file.*
